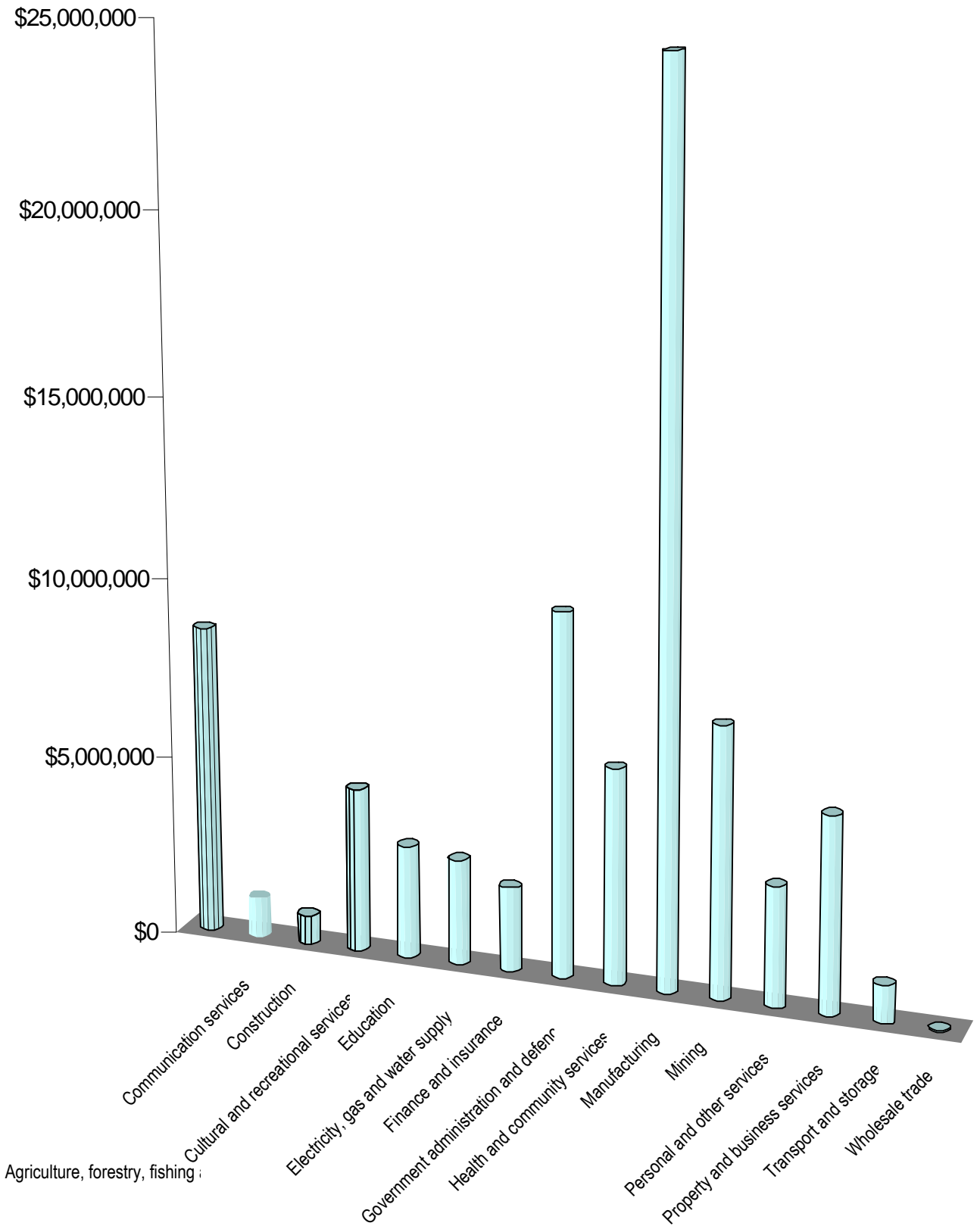

Figure 2: Submitted and Funded Applications for SPIRT Grants (1998-2000)

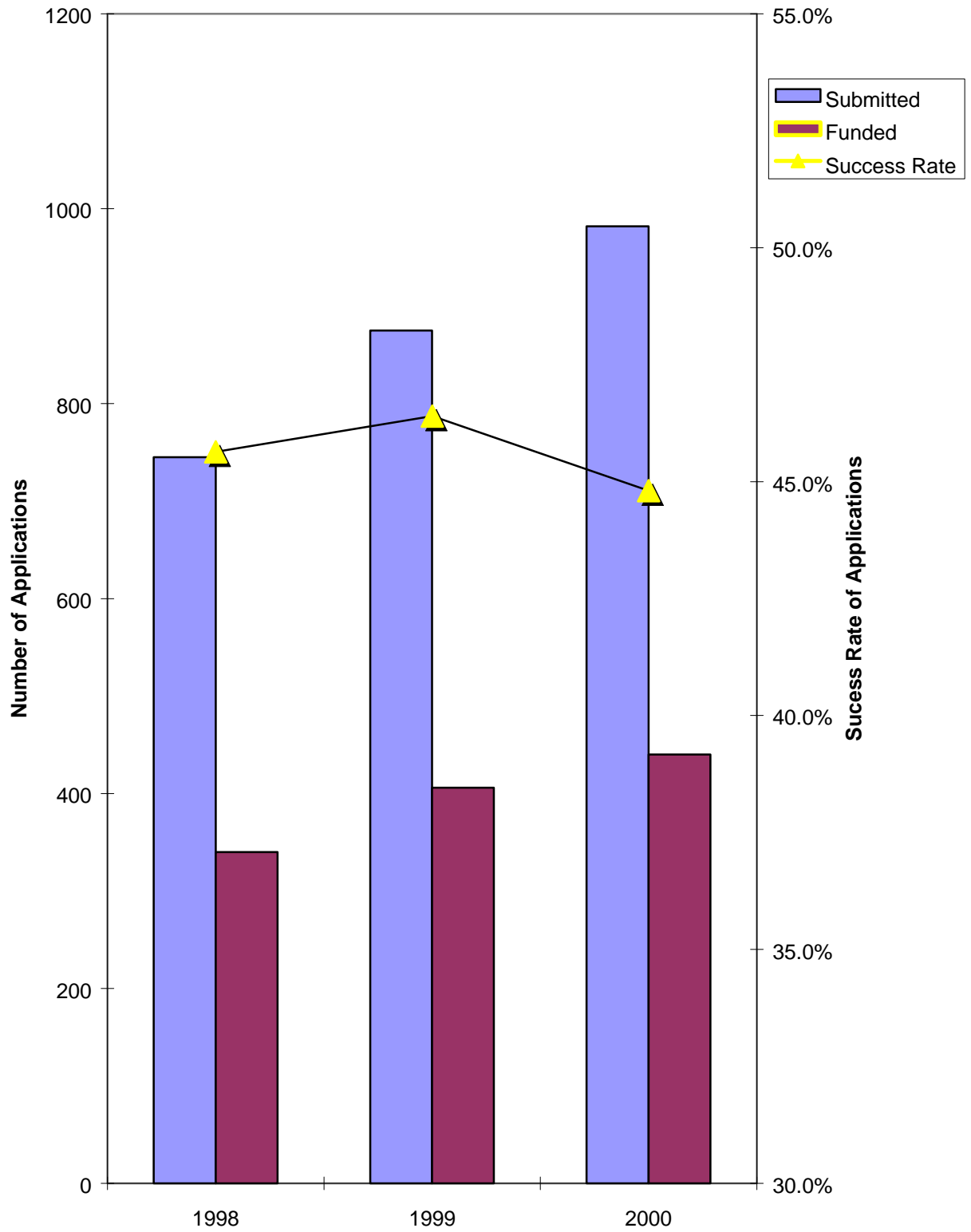


Figure3: Funded Components of SPIRT Grants (1998-2000)
