- Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering
- Australian Academy of Science
- Australian Academy of the Humanities
- Academy of the Social Sciences in Australia.

The objective of the Linkage Learned Academies Special Projects scheme is to support the development of Australian research. The scheme aims to provide the these Learned Academies with the flexibility to achieve that objective.

Research programs must encompass research that advances Australian research itself and/or addresses substantive themes.
