

## Acknowledging the ARC and Logo Use

Grant recipients are required to appropriately acknowledge ARC's contribution to research and other activities in line with their Grant Agreement. The ARC logo should be included in this acknowledgement.

Permission to use the ARC logo must be granted by the ARC. To request permission, email <a href="mailto:communications@arc.gov.au">communications@arc.gov.au</a> with details of the ARC-funded project and how the logo will be used.

## Using the ARC Logo





Logo use must comply with the <u>Australian Government Branding Design Guidelines</u> about placement, colour and size requirements. For example, the printed Australian Coat of Arms must be a minimum of 20mm.

If you have questions about the use of the ARC logo or the Australian Government Crest, please contact ARC Communications or the Honours and Symbols section of the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet at <a href="mailto:governmentbranding@pmc.gov.au">governmentbranding@pmc.gov.au</a>.

When approved, the ARC will provide you logo files for both stacked and in-line versions in a range of formats. We recommend you use EPS or TIFF for print media, GIF for web and JPEG or GIF for Microsoft Office.

## Acknowledging ARC Funding and Disclaimer of Views

ARC support must be acknowledged in all research outputs, including publications, websites, and promotional materials, in accordance with the Grant Agreement. The *Project ID* must be included, and the ARC should be named as a funding body.

ARC-funded Centres should include 'Australian Research Council' or 'ARC' in their titles and display the ARC logo prominently. Researchers awarded an ARC fellowship must acknowledge the specific scheme.

It must also be made clear that any views expressed are those of the authors and not necessarily those of the Australian Government or the ARC.
